Feelings of isolation often accompany the experience of mental illness by people and their families. Isolation is often caused by social stigma: the misconception that mental illness is a question of character or a punishment from God. Language, jokes and misinformation perpetuate stigma. The stigma associated with mental illness can cause people to be hesitant to seek available services and treatment, and can be an obstacle to supportive relationships.
