

## St Mary's Mass Check list

Priests will wear a mask until just before Mass starts. He is the only person to have their masks off once entering the Church.

Priests will not greet people before or after Mass. Congregating before and after Mass is discouraged.

People sanitize their hands upon entering Church.

If the Ushers determine that the Church is full, they will inform those still not seated. They are encouraged to watch a Mass on their phone, listen on the radio. They may then come in and receive Communion and process immediately out to their car. This will help us determine how many Masses we need. We will add as many Masses as it takes to seat everyone comfortably. Please bear with us as we work out these details.

Everyone 10 years of age or older must wear a mask.

Disinfectant wipes will be available to wipe down your pew area before and after Mass.

No servers and No EM's. Dcn Brian will distribute Communion.

Lector may remove mask to read, then replace mask. Deacon wears mask unless speaking

No Offertory Procession or Gifts brought up. Ushers will bring the collection in a basket and place it at the foot of the Altar.

It is encouraged that you only receive the Body of Christ in the hand. If you insist on receiving the Body of Christ on the tongue during this Pandemic, please be last in line.

Please observe the blue lines as to maintain 6' of distance between you and other congregants.

Please do not come forward during Communion for a blessing.

In lieu of a recessional hymn, people are dismissed by row starting nearest the doors.
