

The following is the work schedule for the 2017 St Mary's Thanksgiving celebration.

Saturday, November 18th: Kenneth and Rickey Leding will pick up the last of the goods needed at CV's. We could use some help around 11:00 that morning to unload all of the groceries at the hall.

Sunday, November 19th: We will start work after the Sunday morning mass. That day we will need assistance to set up the tables and chairs. We will also need the assistance of the CCD classes to once again put the plastic ware in the paper sleeves. We will also be baking the cornbread and drying the bread which will be used by the women for making the dressing on Tuesday, the 21st.

Monday, November 20th: We will start work at 8:00 am, which consists of cooking the hens and getting the broth for the dressing, as well as chopping up the meat off of the hens; getting the onions, celery, and butter for the dressing chopped and cooked. Also we'll be getting the bacon and onions chopped/cut and cooked for the beans and kraut.

Tuesday, November 21st: We will start work at 8:00 am, which consists of getting the dressing ingredients warmed up for the ladies to prepare the dressing so they can start on the dressing around 10:00 am. We will also be baking approximately 3-4 dozen various pies, as well as baking additional bread for the Thanksgiving meal.

Wednesday, November 22rd: We will start work at 5:00 am. We will be baking the turkeys, pulling the meat off of the bones, and slicing the white meat. We will also be making the tea for the next day, prepping the cranberry sauce, and various other tasks which will need to be completed. Breakfast will be provided for the workers.

Thursday, November 23rd: We will start work at 6:00 am. There are too many tasks to be mentioned, but we need a good turnout of workers beginning at that time. Breakfast will be provided for the workers.
