

The following is the work schedule for the St Mary's Thanksgiving celebration.

Saturday, November 17<sup>th</sup>: Kenneth and Rickey Leding will pick up the last of the goods needed at CV's.

Sunday, November 18<sup>th</sup>: We will start work after the Sunday morning mass. That day we will need assistance to set up the tables and chairs. We will also need the assistance of the CCD classes to once again put the plastic ware in the paper sleeves. We will also be baking the cornbread and drying the bread for the dressing.
